Overview

The Healthcare Analytics fellowship is a full-time opportunity located in Chicago that begins during the summer of each year.

The fellows work directly with the Group SVP of Advanced Analytics and Product Management/Medical Director to assist in internal and external analyses using data from Vizient's clinical and operational databases, including the Clinical Database/Resource Manager (CDB/RM) as well as external databases as needed.

Vizient's Fellowship Journey

1992 to 2010: The Alexander Schmidt Fellowship was a two-year opportunity centered around health technology assessment, clinical research and pharmacoepidemiology. Nine fellows graduated from this program – many of whom still work at Vizient today – and went on to publish various abstracts and publications based on their epidemiological and pharmaceutical research.

2010 to 2024: Vizient sunset the Alexander Schmidt Fellowship program – replacing it with the current Quantitative Fellowship program under David Levine.

2024 and Onwards: Vizient rebranded the Quantitative fellowship program as the Healthcare Analytics fellowship

The Fellowship Role

This fellowship supports Vizient's Comparative Data and Performance Improvement strategic plan with a focus on leveraging data. Fellows engage in quantitative analyses, project management and collaborative efforts with internal stakeholders and members and use analytical tools to help quality and clinical staff develop strategies to improve performance and drive innovation. They also help enhance current products and services – focusing on data-driven performance improvement tools – and develop new analytics to better serve our members' needs.

Projects

Fellowship projects focus on performance improvement, quality / safety assessment and health services research for Vizient's diverse membership of academic medical centers, complex teaching hospitals, community hospitals, pediatric facilities, integrated health delivery networks and non-acute health care providers. Fellows work with the internal analytics teams and directly with members on various initiatives – gaining exposure to senior-level executives from more than 100 academic medical centers, integrated health systems and community hospitals.

Application Requirements, Process and Timeline

Qualifications

Qualified applicants will have a Master's degree or higher in a related field (MHA, MBA, MPH, etc.) and have completed an internship in a medical setting. Applicants should have strong quantitative and project management skills, including familiarity in performance improvement methodology is preferred. Additionally, applicants should have strong academic records, written and verbal skills and project management capabilities.

Requirements

Qualified applicants will need to submit the following:

- Resume
- Personal Statement
- Letter of Recommendation
- Project Portfolio (required for final interviews)

Timeline

- **1st Oct:** Applications due
- **Early/Mid Oct:** Initial phone interviews with HR
- **Late Oct/Early Nov:** Interviews with current and former fellows
- **Mid-Late Nov:** Final interviews program mentors and preceptors
- **Late Nov/Early Dec:** Offers extended

Pay and Benefits

Fellows receive a salary competitive with fellowship programs as well as a competitive benefits package, including health care insurance, dental and vision plans, retirement plan eligibility, a generous paid time off package, childcare and health care reimbursement accounts and disability and life insurance. We also offer a short-term incentive plan and provide support to attend conferences.
