


Northeast Purchasing Coalition (NPC)



The Northeast Purchasing Coalition Pharmacy Network is a pharmacy aggregation group comprised of 20 health systems, representing more than 159 acute care facilities and over **\$10.5 billion** in pharmacy spend. Since inception in December 2013, member hospitals have achieved over **\$400 million** in implemented savings. NPC's structure provides a mechanism for integrating evidenced based practice with contracting strategies and is led by a Pharmacy Operations Committee comprised of member pharmacy leaders. This allows all participating organizations to synchronize their internal operations and goals to maximize speed to value. The group has experienced continued member growth and brings industry leading value in many categories including biosimilars, intravenous immune globulin/albumin, ortho-viscoelastics, inhalers, MRI contrast, influenza vaccine and many more.




