
TPC Pharmacy Network



The TPC Pharmacy Network is a pharmacy aggregation comprised of 9 health systems, representing 15 acute care facilities and over \$300 million in annual pharmacy spend. Since inception in May 2018, member hospitals have achieved over \$9.5 million in implemented pharmacy savings. TPC's structure utilizes a Pharmacy Clinical Value Analysis Team (CVAT) for reviewing and implementing contracting strategies that align with evidenced based practice. The CVAT consists of pharmacy leaders from each of the member health systems. The TPC Pharmacy CVAT focuses on operational opportunities that address strategy alignment for Member (known as Systemness to TPC Member) but still allows for member individuality when needed. This has led to significant outcomes in the areas of pharmacy distribution, blood and plasma products, antivenins, 503b outsourced sterile compounding, biosimilars, contrast, influenza and other vaccines.


