## Travel

Occasional travel may be required. Professional meetings may include the American Society of Health- System Pharmacists (ASHP) Midyear Clinical Meeting and Vizient Pharmacy Network pre-meeting. Travel expenses are reimbursed for meetings and rotation activities that are approved by the residency program director, per Vizient policy.

Applications are due no later than Tuesday, Jan. 6, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. PST.

## Eligibility requirements

- Graduation from a pharmacy program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE)
- Completion of online application including:
  - Curriculum vitae
  - Letter of intent
  - Three letters of recommendation
  - Copy of transcripts from ACPE-accredited pharmacy program
- Completion (or pending completion) of ASHP-accredited PGY1 pharmacy residency or equivalent career experience.
- Equivalent experience will be considered in the application process. If a candidate is selected under this criterion they will be classified as a Fellow.
- Active pharmacy licensure or eligibility for licensure in the state of Illinois.
