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Vizient Oncology Network (VON)

The Vizient Oncology Network (VON) is a pharmacy aggregation group that was established in 2020 to bring together health system oncology practices and clinics to drive savings of branded products and achieve better patient outcomes. VON's membership is comprised of 56 health systems including 14 NCCN cancer centers. VON represents an annual oncology drug spend of approximately \$8.4 billion, of which \$5.0 billion is in GPO spend. The VON pharmacy aggregation group is led by an Executive Steering Committee, comprised of member pharmacy leaders to provide direction on initiatives and recommend strategies for the VON members. VON continues to grow and strives to be the leader in oncology pharmacy practice and sourcing strategies by utilizing evidence-based medicine to enhance contracting opportunities and improve patient care.

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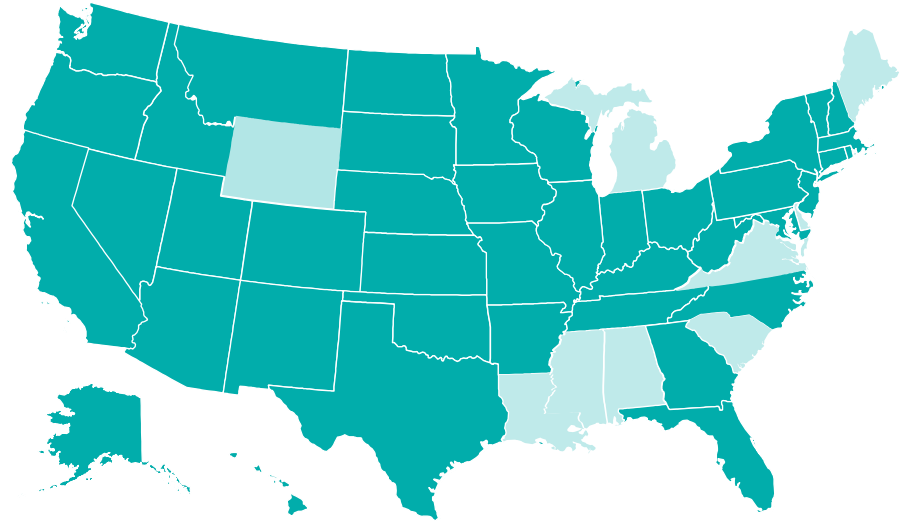
