CONFERENCE TOPICS

Regulatory and accreditation compliance

This component emphasizes the importance of complying with regulatory requirements and accreditation standards in healthcare settings. Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of the regulatory landscape and various accreditation bodies, with a specific focus on TJC and CMS standards. The program prepares participants for successful surveys and assessments. It covers essential elements such as readiness reviews, mock surveys, documentation preparation and compliance with TJC and CMS standards. Risk identification and mitigation
