
Independent Hospital Network (IHN)

Many IHN pharmacy Member are part of the IHN supply network, and this interdisciplinary partnership helps to further drive value and opportunity beyond the walls of the pharmacy. IHN pharmacy Member hip includes **18 health systems** in Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Missouri and Ohio and represent over **\$471 million** in annual pharmacy spend. Since the inception in 2016, IHN Pharmacy aggregation Member have saved over \$36.5M with the cumulative ROI in 2023 being 8:1.


